Standard Operating Procedure

(WO c) Drill - Hand held



PURPOSE:

To ensure the Hand Held Drill is operated in a safe manner to minimise the risk of injury to the operator

PERSONAL PROTECTECTION EQUIPMENT (PPE) REQUIRED:

Workboots Ear Protection Eye Protection Hi Vis Clothing

CERTIFICATES, LICENCES OR TRAINING REQUIRED TO OPERATE:

Induction by Farm Manager

PROCEDURES:

- 1. Ensure lead is tagged & in good working order.
- 2. Ensure drill is safe to use & in good working order
- 3. Adjust chuck putting in appropriate drill bit
- 4. Once drill bit is in, tighten up check bit with chuck key
- 5. Plug into power source.
- 6. Pull trigger, commence drilling with both hands.
- 7. Hold drill firmly.
- 8. Avoid wearing loose clothing.
